

## Celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Swedish Chamber of Commerce in France

A century dedicated to the commercial exchange between France and Sweden – this motto will set the tone for the celebrations during the jubilee year. 

The Paris Opera hosts for this occasion one of the oldest dance companies in Europe, founded in 1773 by King Gustav III. The Royal Ballet of Sweden presents a new production created for the company's 240<sup>th</sup> anniversary by the Swedish dancer and choreographer Mats Ek. Mats Ek, who plays a key role in the world of theatre and contemporary dance, proposes an interpretation of Shakespeare's tragedy, renamed *Juliet et Romeo*. Mats Ek is inspired by the music of Tchaikovsky and offers a personal vision of this mythical story, one of love confronted by rivalry, family conflicts and the struggle for power.

Openness to the world, curiosity and innovation are values that largely characterize Swedish dance, as well as Swedish companies and business. Mats Ek, one of the most important names in contemporary dance, overturns the conventions of classic ballet.
